School Pictures will take place on September 8th at the high school. The photography studio will be mailing home information shortly with pricing and packaging options for your review.

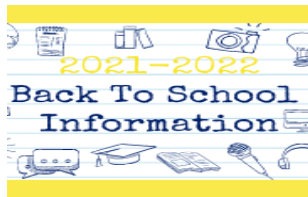


Parents, please remind your student to arrive with their school laptop **fully charged on the first day of school. (Please have them bring their laptop charger with them.)**

Returning Registration – 2021-2022

All families need to update their Family/Student information via the online link on the district website: **Registration / Returning Student Registration.**

All parents/ guardians will be notified shortly with the instructions and a “**Snap Code**” for you to complete all the information electronically online. This allows you to make any changes and updates necessary. You may use the same account for multiple children in the Foxborough School System.

It is very important that the information is accurate and up-to-date. Contact phone numbers and email addresses will be the means of communication between parent and or guardians.

Once corrections/updates are made, the data is updated in Power School. From this data, we are able to send out timely school information on dates such as upcoming SAT's, school events, or information that may not be available on the most recent version of the Foxworthy.

In the event of an emergency, we are able to send out mass emails / voicemails pertaining to the school.

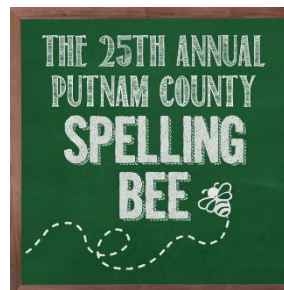
ANTI-HAZING LAW

On January 8, 2002, President Bush signed into law the “No Child Left Behind Act.” As part of this law, recruiters from the United States Armed Forces can request student directory information from all public and private high schools that receive federal funding. THE PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT OF HEAD INJURIES AND CONCUSSIONS IN EXTRACURRICULAR ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES

Policy Adopted 1-30-12

A concussion is a head injury to the brain and concussions are serious. A concussion may be defined as the immediate and transient impairment of neurological function. It may be a consequence of an athlete's head striking an object (such as a floor or another head), an object striking the head (such as a ball, bat, stick, or another head), or as a result of a sudden change in the direction of the head and neck (such as in a whiplash type of injury). Concussions generally cause specific signs that can be observed by others and symptoms that are reported by the athlete. Recognition and proper management of concussions can prevent further injury and even death. Recognition and appropriate management of concussions requires coordinated effort of a number of people as outlined in M.G.L.c.111, section 222 and 105 CMR 201.00.

DRESS CODE

Appropriate dress reflects positively on the school community, and students will be prohibited from wearing any clothing that compromises health, safety, or cleanliness or that causes a distraction to the educational mission of the school. All students must adhere to the following minimum standards:

1. Students are not permitted to wear hat or hoods during school hours unless permission is granted by the Administration. Students must remove head coverings as soon as they enter the building and place them in lockers, book bags or other secure places.
2. Clothing must not have any offensive words that may include, but are not limited to, references to violence, alcohol, tobacco, sex, or illicit drugs.
3. Clothing must cover the abdomen and undergarments. Students are not allowed to wear clothes that expose cleavage. Halter-tops, see-through garments, low cut blouses, tube tops, and muscle shirts are not to be worn.
4. Skirts, dresses and shorts must be of reasonable length (e.g. fingertip length).

The school administration reserves the right to determine whether students' dress is within the standards of acceptability. Students not dressing in accordance with this policy shall be instructed to correct the violation.
