<p>Self-quarantine for 14 days after the last exposure to the person who tested positive.</p> <p>Even if this CC tests negative, the CC must continue to self quarantine for the full 14 days as COVID-19 may take up to 14 days to cause CC to be ill.</p>	<p>May return to school after 10 days isolation and</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Improvement in symptoms ● No fever for 24 hours without fever reducing medications ● received clearance from public health authority 	<p>If a provider has documented an alternative diagnosis, the individual may return to school based on the recommendations for that alternative diagnosis (e.g., influenza or strep pharyngitis)</p>	<p>The individual may return when there is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Improvement in symptoms <p>AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No fever for more than 24 hours without fever reducing medications 	<p>The individual may return to school 10 days from start of symptoms if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Symptoms have improved <p>AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No fever for more than 24 hours without fever reducing medications
